ABOUT THE SUPPORT GROUP

CADA's sexual harm support group is facilitated by a licensed therapist and is for those identifying as women who have experienced sexual assault, harassment, abuse, or any unwanted sexual contact or harm. All groups are free and confidential, and meant to be judgment-free and affirming spaces where no one will be forced or pressured to share. Participants are expected to be 18+.

WHAT YOU'LL BE DOING

- Facilitating an in-person, weekly group of female-identifying survivors of sexual harm
- Preparing materials designed to open up conversation and support the group in healing
- Supporting participants in taking the lead in discussions and being an integral part of taking the group where it needs to go
- Promoting the group when able and/or through naturally existing platforms in collaboration with CADA's efforts

- You're a licensed provider - we can contract with an individual or agency -- seeking an independent contract opportunity to facilitate a weekly in-person group
- You have an understanding of relationship abuse, sexual violence, trauma, substance use disorders, and mental health

- You're compassionate, empathetic, and nonjudgmental individual who cares about the safety of survivors of relationship abuse and sexual violence.
- You're good at thinking on your feet and able to quickly assess a situation and act confidently
- You're skilled at communication and conflict mediation
